Painting the Still Life/Interior, Spring 2016: Supply List
Class sessions will begin with discussions of other artists work including images of their works, and resources. Addressing the Still Live/Interior and the history that comes with it.
We will be working on 2 medium scale pieces ( $30 \times 30 \mathrm{in}, 30 \times 40 \mathrm{in}$ ) for the 2 days of the course.
Bring still life objects that are meaningful to you to incorporate into the still life. Fabric, pitchers, fruits, flowers, trucks, interesting mechanical parts...be inventive.

## General Supplies

Vine Charcoal, soft
Push pins
Masking Tape roll
Rags
Bounty Paper Towels
Sketch book $8 \times 10$, or $9 \times 12$ (for taking notes, small sketches)
Pencils, HB, 4B or Graphite sticks
"Staedtler Mars" brand plastic eraser
"Design" brand kneaded eraser
Viewfinder
Gloves
Apron
Medium container, large clip on
Large Paper Palettes, at least $18^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ (Dick Blick) or large masonite/wood Palette

## Oil Paint

Suggested list of colors for a basic palette: (One tube each)
Titanium/Zinc White 120-200 ml tube
Indian Yellow
Cadmium Yellow Light, Pale or Lemon
Cadmium Yellow Medium
Cadmium Orange (Gamblin)
Cadmium Red Light (Gamblin/Utrecht) or Scarlet (Windsor Newton)
Quinocrodone Red, Rose or Magenta
Alizarin Crimson
Cerulean Blue
Cobalt Blue
Ultramarine Blue
Viridian
Ivory Black
Optional: Phalo Blue, Cobalt Teal (Gamblin)

- Palette knife: To mix paint and to apply paint. A knife with a blade about 3 or $4^{\prime \prime}$ in length and $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide is good for general use. Knives that bend where the blade attaches to the handle are easier to use.
- Solvent: Only ODORLESS Gamsol or Thin-X. Bring a covered container with solvent for cleaning brushes. (Mayo jar)
- Palette cup: Large Metal clip-on cups
- Medium: Stand or Linseed oil + solvent and a container like Mayo Jars,
- Brushes: Natural Bristle brushes. Have a variety; rounds, filberts, flats from \#8 to \#14. Extra large, cheap brushes from hardware store, $2^{\prime \prime}, 4^{\prime \prime}$


## Supports

Oil primed linen is preferred though expensive. Acrylic primed linen or canvas as alternate.
2 medium size canvas, $30 \times 30 / 30 \times 40$, or similar. The longest dimension should be at least 30 inches.
