## FOR COLLAGE:

## Papers

Variety of assorted solid colored papers: small sheets of Canson paper, Color Aid, origami papers, handmade papers \&/or construction papers.
Multimedia paper, watercolor or Bristol paper for collage backings.
2-3 sheets of White or Buff rice paper (Mulberry is nice) \& fibrous white paper like Rives.
6 sheets of 8 "x10"-8.5"x11" cardstock any color.

## Pigments:

Watercolor or Gouache in tubes (basic primary colors) \&/or colored inks in primary colors.
6-8 small jars for making diluted pigment.
WC paint brushes $1 / 2$ " flat and assorted. Glue brush.

## Other:

Sketchbook (approx 9"x12"), pencil \& ballpoint pen.
Liquid glue, strong glue stick and scissors.
Trace paper
Saral Transfer paper or carbon paper
Paper towels.
Water jar.

## Paint:

Acrylic or oil...something you are familiar with in a limited palette.
( 3 primaries, white and perhaps an earth tone like an umber.)
Palette for mixing paints
Rags
Surfaces to work on in a variety of sizes (No smaller than 8 "x10")
You might consider working on paper as it can be cut into and collaged as well.
(If you are working in oil on paper, it must be primed.)
*You do not need brushes and mediums for the palette knife painting.
