Suggested Painting Supplies:

Pick only one for the class: Acrylics or Oils

Recommended paint colors, all large tubes (to cut costs, purchase student grade and/or hues of the color)

- Cadmium Red or Naphthal Red
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Ultramarine Blue
- Titanium White
- small tube of Black

Other supplies

- Variety of brushes
- 1" house painting brush or sponge brushes
- Metal pallet knife
- Pallet – Freezer Paper from Grocery store
- 9X12 and 16x20 painting surface (canvas board or just a primed board) to start.
- Containers for water/medium
- Oil painters – walnut oil with alkyd and safflower cooking oil (for cleaning)*
- Acrylic painters – acrylic Matt medium or something similar to this.
- Rags or paper towels

Optional Paint colors

- Alizarin Crimson or Rose madder or Quinacridone Magenta
- Cadmium Yellow Light or Cadmium Lemon or Lemon Yellow
- Yellow Ochre
- Cerulean Blue, Manganese Blue or Cobalt Blue

Optional supplies

- Oil painters - Murphy's Oil soap for cleaning your oil brushes or any soap
- Acrylic painters - spray bottle, ivory soap to clean brushes, paper cups, plastic spoons
- Masking tape
- Soft Charcoal

* no solvents or citrus products allowed
