## Jill Pottle Painting Supply Lists:

## Acrylic Painting:

o 1.5" - 2" house painting brushes \&/or sponge brushes, (the made in China brushes at the hardware store are fine)
o pallet knife
o Acrylic matte and gloss mediums (Liquitex) or painting medium of your choosing
o rags or paper towels
o 18 "x24" or something close to this size: paper pallet or a roll of Freezer Paper (this can be purchased at a grocery store, not wax paper)
o plastic wrap
o suggestion only: Muffin tray with zip lock bag or Masterson Wet Pallet
o container for medium and one for water
o Diptych? Three canvas panels Triptych? Four Canvas panels
(same size or for tryptic, same size on each side, larger in middle) (will discuss in class)
Sketch pad and pencils
soft charcoal or pencil
o spray bottle
o masking tape
o variety of brushes \#10 and up (no small brushes), buy a round, flat and filbert for variety.

Make sure they are acrylic brushes, synthetic brushes with long handles.
o paper cups and plastic spoons.
o My favorite brand of paint: Golden or Windsor Newton.

## Oil Painting:

o \#10 size brushes \& larger (filbert brushes are great but feel free to get some round and
flat brushes)
o 1-3" house painting brushes
o 18"X24" or large size paper pallet or freezer paper
o Murphy's Oil soap or brush cleaner
o rags \&/or paper towels
o metal pallet knife
o masking tape
o metal paint cups
o same painting surfaces as above and sketch book
o One of the following: \#1Artist's professional grade Walnut Alkyd Medium. \#2 Gamblin solvent free gel. No premixed oil mediums. NO SOLVENTS or citrus products to be used in class.
o Safflower Oil used for cleaning brushes in between colors
o Water base oils are fine
o Two glass jars with metal tops for waste
o Regular oil paint brands: Gamblin, Grumbacher, Windsor Newton
PAINT COLORS: Cadmium Red Medium or Vermilion, (as a less expensive alternative), Cad. Yellow Medium, Ultramarine Blue, large tube of Titanium White, Other colors you might consider: Alizarin Crimson or Rose madder or Quinacridone Magenta, Cad. Yellow Light Cad. or Lemon Yellow Cad., Yellow Ochre, Cerulean Blue or Maganese or Cobalt Blue
